VOLUNTEERS NEEDED KANSAS GUARDIANSHIP PROGRAM

Each year many Kansans are declared by the courts as in need of a guardian and/or conservator. The **Kansas Guardianship Program** is a statewide program which recruits volunteers to be appointed guardians and/or conservators for many of these persons. The program serves those individuals who have limited resources and no family member available to assist them.

A GUARDIAN/CONSERVATOR:

- is an advocate
- is Court appointed
- visits ward or conservatee regularly
- manages finances
- files annual accounting with the Court
- reports monthly to the KGP
- receives a small monthly stipend

For this important volunteer work, the **Kansas Guardianship Program** seeks **EXCEPTIONAL VOLUNTEERS** who are wise, caring, with high levels of integrity, concerned about the rights of persons with disabilities and willing to advocate for and protect the welfare of the ward and/or conservatee.
